

Some curriculum updates

Language Arts

Our spelling words this week are so, go, no, home, hole, rope, Ijoke, bone, stove, and poke (we are focusing on words with long o, either at the end of a syllable (like "go") or those that end with "Super E." Our challenge word is valentine! Our dictation sentence is "Look at the cat now."

We will be reading informational texts this week centering around space, identifying the main idea and details of a text, and practicing using question marks when writing sentences that are asking something. Students are also practicing editing their writing--looking for any errors and correcting them.

We are finishing up our unit on penguins this week! Be on the I lookout for your child's "Penguin Book" and "Penguin Research Book "Students absolutely loved learning about penguins, and there are quite a few first graders who now have a new favorite animal!

We are so excited to celebrate Valentine's Day together this week! We will be passing out valentines, eating a fun snack, and spending the week reflecting on and acknowledging all the love in our lives! Keep any eye out for a special surprise in your mail later this week from your child!

STAR OF THE WEEK


