Math

We finished up our study of place value last week and are moving into two-digit addition and subtraction! Using our knowledge of tens and ones, we can quickly add numbers. If we think of 20 + 40, we can think of this addition problem as adding 2 tens plus 4 tens, which equals 6 tens (or 60). We've also been practicing counting on by tens to add. For example, if the problem is 34 + 20, we can put 34 in our head and count on 2 tens: 44, 54.

Language Arts

Our spelling words this week are me, be, read, feet, tree, keep, eat, mean, sea, and these (we are focusing on words with long e that either end with "Super e" or have a double vowel pattern of either ee or ea). Our challenge word is <u>Seattle!</u> Our dictation sentence is "She can see my dog."

Science/Social Studies


