Religion: This week we will learn about saints: holy men and women of God who love others and put God first. They are the superheroes of our church! Our fourth graders, dressed as various saints, will be leading our school community in prayer as we celebrate All Saints Day together.

Language Arts: We will read informational texts on animals and how they communicate, practice using commas when writing a list or a series, and start our spelling notebooks this week! Using our phonograms, we will spell words together, which we will analyze for spelling rules, phonograms, etc. Beginning next week we'll have weekly spelling tests (more information to come!).

Math: We are continuing to work on subtraction this week. We've been practicing finding all the ways to subtract from 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 (ie: 10-1, 10-2, 10-3, 10-4, etc.)

*One of our grade level standards is to count by 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s to 120. Students can practice counting in the car, while waiting in line at the grocery store, while playing hide and seek, etc.
