This Week in 1A

Religion: We will learn about God's gift of creation and His love for us. We'll discuss how we can share God's love for us and how we can help to take care of His creation.

Handwriting: We will introduce the "stop family," which include all sounds in which we stop our breath. These phonograms include p, b, t, d, k, g, ch, and j. As we write, we will work on using the six handwriting strokes to form letters. We are writing with our pinch grips, using our thumb and first & second fingers to pinch the writing tool.

Language Arts: We will read about weather this week; skills include reading/writing words with short i, identifying possessive nouns, writing captions, and understanding characters.

Math: We are continuing our study of addition this week. We will learn about adding vertically and find ways to make 4, 5, 6, and 7. For example, ways to make 5 would be: $0+5$, $1+4$, $2+3$, $3+2$, $4+1$, and $5+0$. We will learn & use the vocabulary word "sum."

Science: We'll discuss the seasons and celebrate the beginning of fall (first day is this Thursday, September 22nd)!
