This Week in 1A

Religion: In our chapter "Jesus Teaches Us to Pray", we will learn the ways, places, and reasons we pray. We'll learn more about the Lord's Prayer and what it means when we pray it together.

Language Arts: Our spelling words this week are **so, go, no, home, hole, rope, joke, bone, stove, and poke**; we are focusing on words with long o this week (like those found at the end of a syllable, like "go," or those that end with super/magic e, like "home"). Our challenge word is **penguin!** Our dictation sentence is: **It is cold out.**

We'll identify the main idea and details of a text, as well as practice using question marks while writing questions. Students are working hard to edit their own writing-checking for capitals, punctuation, proper spacing, letter formation, etc.

Math: We'll introduce the hundreds place this week, as we focus on identifying and writing numbers to 120. We'll use mental math to determine ten more and ten less than any given one or two-digit number.

Star of the Week




CARSON
