




PEEK AT OUR WEEK

This Week in 1A


Religion: We'll read the story of Noah and learn how we can say "yes" to God. Catholics believe that God invites everyone into his Kingdom. The Kingdom of God is the world of love, peace, and justice that is in Heaven and is still being built on Earth.

Language Arts: Our spelling words this week are **me, be, read, eat, mean, sea, feet, tree, keep, these** (we are focusing on words with long e). Our challenge word is **Valentine's Day**. Our dictation sentence is: **Look at me!**

We will learn about compound sentences this week. We can connect two complete sentences with a comma and a conjunction. For example: "Is your sister here? Is she at home?" could become "Is your sister here, or is she at home?"

Math: We are comparing numbers using the greater than > and less than < symbols, as well as reading and writing three-digit numbers to 120. We'll continue to review finding ten more and ten less than a given number (for example: 42, 52, 62), as this will be important in our next unit on adding & subtracting two-digit numbers.

Science: We are immersed in all things penguin! Ask your child about his/her favorite penguin fact!
