This Week in 1A

Religion: Lent is a forty day journey that begins on Ash Wednesday (last Wednesday, February 22nd). During Lent, Catholics promise to repent or change to grow closer to God by fasting, praying, and serving others. During Lent the Church uses the color purple for Church vestments as a sign of repentance.

Language Arts: Our spelling words are **sail, mail, rain, grain, pain, may, play, way, day, and stay** ("ai" says "a" in the middle of a word, while "ay" says "a" at the end of a word). Our challenge word is **Lent**! Our dictation sentence is: **Will you play with me?**

We'll learn where food comes from this week, draw conclusions from texts we read, use commas when writing the date, and identify and write more contractions.

Math: We have moved into our study of two-digit addition and subtraction! Using our knowledge of tens and ones, we can quickly add numbers. When solving $20 + 40$, we can think of it as 2 tens + 4 tens = 6 tens (or 60). We can count on by tens to add. When solving $34 + 30$, we can put 34 in our head and count on 3 tens: 44, 54, 64.

Social Studies: We will start a unit on our country this week!
